Rich, sumptuous and exquisitely layered, but with the restraint that runs through all the Chardonnays, the Cuvee Torchiana is terrific. 2015	Cabernet Sauvignon Herb Lamb Vineyard	Tor's 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Herb Lamb Vineyard is terrific. In a vintage in which so many wines are monolithic, the Herb Lamb possesses captivating aromatics and silky tannins that seem to bring out the best this site has to offer. Super-ripe red cherry, raspberry, hard candy and wild flowers give the 2015 a level of sensual exoticism that is impossible to miss. There is so much to like. 2015	Cabernet Sauvignon Melanson Vineyard	Tor's 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Melanson Vineyard is super. Succulent red cherry, rose petal, menthol, licorice and hard candy are all pushed forward. This is an especially ripe, flamboyant wine built on forward fruit and fleshiness. 2015	Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville Hillside Tierra Roja Vineyard	Tor's 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville Hillside Tierra Roja Vineyard includes a dollop of 5% Cabernet Franc from To Kalon. A powerful, structured wine, the Oakville Hillside is going to need at least a few years to allow the tannins to soften. This is an especially tannic, imposing 2015 Cabernet. 2015	Red Wine	The 2015 Red Wine is a blend of 44% Petit Verdot from Vine Hill Ranch, 44% Cabernet Franc from To Kalon and 12% Cabernet Sauvignon from To Kalon. Dark, rich and explosive, the 2015 hits the palate with serious intensity and brooding power. Gravel, graphite, smoke, and black cherry infuse this persistent, super-intriguing wine.
