2018 TOR Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville Leading off the reds, the appellation 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville shows the rich, concentrated style of all these 2018s from Tor. Loads of pure crème de cassis, blackberries, licorice, tobacco, and loamy soil emerge from this full-bodied, rounded, mouth-filling beauty, which has ample mid-palate depth, velvety tannins, and big finish. Enjoy bottles over the coming 10-15 years.	93
2018 TOR Cabernet Sauvignon Tierra Roja Vineyard Another Oakville Cabernet, the 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Tierra Roja Vineyard offers a spicy, complex nose of baked black cherries, plums, currants, bay leaf, sandalwood, and chocolate. This spicy, complex, savory Cabernet is full-bodied and has a wonderfully textured, seamless mouthfeel, present tannins, and a good finish. It's already a joy to drink yet is going to evolve for 20 years or more given its overall balance.	95

2018 TOR Cabernet Sauvignon Vine Hill Ranch

This site in Oakville has been firing on all cylinders recently, and the 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Vine Hill Ranch (100% Cabernet From the rockiest section in the vineyard) is just another example of the incredible quality from the vineyard. Inky purple, its stunning bouquet of crème de cassis, graphite, lead pencil shaving, tobacco, and gravelly earth notes give way to a full-bodied, structured wine that reminds me a great vintage of Smith Haut Lafitte with its incredible earthy minerality as well as finesse and elegance. It needs 4-5 years of bottle age and will keep for 20-30 years.

2018 TOR Pure Magic Beckstoffer To Kalon Vineyard

The 2018 Pure Magic Beckstoffer To Kalon Vineyard comes all from three blocks in To Kalon and was co-fermented. I believe I reviewed this last year from barrel as the To Kalon Vineyard BFD. Thrilling and incredibly pure notes of crème de cassis, spring flowers, damp earth, graphite, and violets all emerge from the glass, and it hits the palate with an ethereal, full-bodied, flawless texture that carries silky tannins and a monster of a finish. It's not the biggest or richest wine in the lineup, but its levels of finesse, balance, and purity are off the charts. This magical wine is perfection in a glass to this reviewer. It should evolve for 25+ years.

2018 TOR Pure Magic Vine Hill Ranch Vineyard

Lastly, the 2018 Pure Magic Vine Hill Ranch Vineyard is a selection from this great vineyard and checks in as 53% Cabernet and 47% Petit Verdot. As with the straight vineyard release, it reveals a vivid purple hue to go with a deep, complex nose of black and blue fruits, crushed violets, chocolate, gravelly earth, and smoked tobacco, Rich, opulent, and sweetly fruited on the palate, this is one sexy, seamless Cabernet Sauvignon that has full-bodied richness, a weightless texture, incredible finesse and purity, and a heavenly finish. It's already approachable yet is going to evolve for 20-30 years or more.

2018 TOR Chardonnay Beresini Vineyard Cuvee Torchiana

Also from Carneros, there are a scant ten barrels of the 2018 Chardonnay Beresini Vineyard Cuvee Torchiana. Giving up plenty of ripe peach, Meyer lemon, toasted bread, and baking spice notes, it hits the palate with medium to full-bodied richness, nicely integrated acidity, and outstanding length on the finish. As with all of these Chardonnays from Tor, it opens up nicely with time in the glass and is impeccably put together. Enjoy bottles over the coming 7-8 years.

2018 TOR Chardonnay Carneros

Moving to the three Carneros releases, the appellation 2018 Chardonnay Carneros offers a medium gold color (all of these are bottled unfined and have a touch of haze in the color, which is not a problem in any way) to go with a rich, powerful bouquet of Meyer lemons, caramelized citrus, toast, honeycomb, and toasted nuts. I love its texture, it's medium to full-bodied, has both freshness and richness, and a great finish. It's another powerful yet balanced, impeccably made Chardonnay.
